Subject : **2019 UNESCO International Literacy Prizes**

Sir/Madam,

On behalf of the Director-General, I have the honour hereby to launch the call to nominate candidates for the 2019 edition of the **UNESCO International Literacy Prizes**, on the theme '**Literacy and Multilingualism**'. Initially established in 1967, these Prizes include the two UNESCO King Sejong Literacy Prizes, sponsored by the Republic of Korea and the three UNESCO Confucius Prizes for Literacy, sponsored by the People's Republic of China. They are awarded each year to individuals, governments and non-governmental organizations in recognition of their distinguished contribution to the promotion of literacy, and their meritorious efforts in this regard.

It is strongly recommended that nomination files take this year's theme into consideration, as well as the specific thematic focus of each Prize, which is "the development and use of mother-tongue literacy education and training" for the UNESCO King Sejong Literacy Prize, and "literacy amongst adults in rural areas and out-of-school youth, particularly girls and women" for the UNESCO Confucius Prize for Literacy.

I am pleased to invite non-governmental organizations maintaining official partnerships with UNESCO to submit nominations for this year's edition of the Prizes. Each NGO can propose up to three nominations for the UNESCO Confucius Prize for Literacy, and up to two nominations for the UNESCO King Sejong Literacy Prize.

The online nominations should be received by UNESCO in English or French by **23 June 2019 at the very latest**. Any nomination received after midnight of 23 June 2019 (UTC+1, Paris time), or through a different channel or means, will not be considered.
